Governance of interorganizational networks for joint projects

- <u>Purpose:</u> understand the relationships of networked organizations over time
- **Goal:** a framework for governing, managing and improving network relationships between partner organizations
- Method: 3 step process. Start now with interviews within organizations involved in construction projects







Governance of interorganizational networks for joint projects

- We are looking for: organizations, to interview about 5 people with knowledge about network partners and when to involve them.
- Effort: Five online interviews of approx. 45 minutes each
- **WIIFM** (what's in it for me?):
 - continuous updates on the research findings via a shared website
 - a seminar for the organization about the research results and the specifics of their particular organization
 - Insights to improve the own network and its governance.
